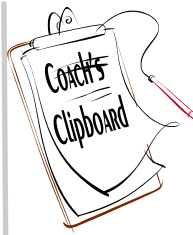
Sowing discord between child and parents, or suggesting a parent shouldn’t be trusted, is also the first tactic used to get someone to join a cult!

## COACH'S CORNER

Parents concerned about the Comprehensive Sexuality Education program their school intends to use will find a helpful tool at **[StopCSE.org](http://StopCSE.org)** under “CSE-materials.”

Federally funded CSE programs are scored individually using a “Harmful Element Analysis.” Each element is documented within the curricula, so parents can use it when discussing their concerns with principals or teachers. As an example, most LAUSD schools are using *Positive Prevention Plus*. It has a **12 out of 15 harmful element score** for both the middle school and high school curricula. Those elements are:

1. Sexualizes children
2. Teaches children to consent to sex
3. Promotes oral and anal sex
4. Promotes homosexual and bisexual experimentation
5. Promotes condom use in inappropriate ways
6. Promotes premature sexual autonomy
7. Fails to establish abstinence as the expect standard
8. Affirms transgender ideology
9. Promotes Contraception/Abortion among children
10. Promotes peer-to-peer sexual rights advocacy
11. Undermines traditional/religious values and beliefs
12. Undermines parental rights
